Dr. Jos Beelen is researcher and consultant on internationalisation of the curriculum at the Centre for Applied Research into Economics and Management at the Amsterdam University of Applied Sciences. He is chair of the Special Interest Group Internationalisation at Home of the European Association for International Education (EAIE) and a visiting fellow at Leeds Metropolitan University's Centre for Academic Practice and Research in Internationalisation (CAPRI).

Jos is a certified senior trainer for EAIE and has facilitated training sessions and workshops in a range of European countries, Latin America, South Africa, Asia and Australia. He has coached academic staff in internationalising academic programmes at universities in The Netherlands, Belgium, Austria, Colombia, Brazil and Australia. For the Columbus Network, he has facilitated on line training courses.

He was the editor EAIE's 'toolkit' *Implementing Internationalisation at Home* (2007) and has since written a range of articles on the same topic, often co-authored with researchers from Europe and Australia. He acts as reviewer for the Journal of Studies in International Education

Jos is currently doing research into the internationalisation of learning outcomes in academic programmes. One of the issues he focuses on is developing the skills of academic staff that enable them to assume ownership of curriculum internationalisation.
